Advice for holidaymakers

There is a high threat of terrorist attacks globally affecting UK interests and British nationals, including from those who view the UK and British nationals as targets.

Terrorist attacks may occur anywhere in the world, usually with little or no warning. You should be vigilant at all times.

While there is no specific intelligence that British holidaymakers will be targeted, this video highlights the steps you can take to minimise the impact of an attack – including knowing the local emergency services number.

Safety and security advice

If you hear gunshots you should:

RUN – to a place of safety. This is better than trying to surrender or negotiate.

HIDE – it is better to hide than confront. Barricade yourself in, turn your phone to silent and use only when it is safe to do so.

TELL – Make sure you know the local emergency numbers in the country you are travelling to. For all EU countries call 112.
